**FACILITIES** — The Studio features 3 spacious studios with sprung floors and professional marley surfaces. Our largest studio is the same size as the Cabrillo Crocker Theater stage, so we are able to rehearse a full flock of swans or swirling snowflakes. The smallest of our studios is equipped with a viewing window, so little dancers are never out of sight. There are changing rooms for both girls and boys, as well as bathrooms on the premises, including a gender-neutral, handicap-accessible changing room and bathroom. Our office sells bottled water and snacks, as well as a snack card, which alleviates the need for dancers to carry cash. Sandy Nelson, our Registrar, is available in the office weekday afternoons to answer any of your questions about our programs, tuition or curriculum. Access to a tuition dropbox is outside the office, for those times you are unable to drop off payments during office hours. All three studios are available for rental — contact our Registrar for details.

**THE STUDIOS ARE AVAILABLE FOR RENTAL** ~ Contact our Registrar Sandy Nelson. Studio C is currently available for long-term exclusive rental, which includes use of public areas, dressing rooms, bathrooms and lobby. Dimensions are 26 feet, 10 inches wide by 22 feet, 8 inches deep. Wall-mounted ballet barres (two heights), full-length and room-width mirror in front, audio equipment which accommodates CDs, iPod and smartphone.
