- 3:30-4:30 pm Dancers age 4-6 years Must be a student of The Studio to qualify in this age group Registration 3:30-4:00 pm. Audition 4-4:30 pm

\$30 Audition Fee per dancer. Dancers must be punctual to qualify for the audition. Girls bring pointe shoes if you dance en pointe. Auditions held at The Studio, School of Classical Ballet.
