This year our Festival Artistic Director (formerly know as the Adjudicator) is Alan Hinline, pictured at left. Alan is part of a panel of three FADs who will evaluate and mentor each company in our organization. Our dancers will take a master class with Mr. Hinline and he will work with us in the studio on the piece(s) he has chosen for Festival performance. The evaluation process is a wonderful way for SCBT to gain valuable feedback from an esteemed professional in the field. Once at the Festival, Alan will serve as Artistic Director of the performance that SCBT participates in, leading the Technical/Dress Rehearsal and again giving valuable support along the way. SCBT will perform on the Tuesday evening concert, which features other California companies south of Santa Cruz in Paso Robles, Santa Barbara and Torrance, as well as our one company in Arizona. The two other FADs will evaluate and assist companies in Northern California, Washington, Idaho, Utah, Nebraska and Indiana. We look forward to working with Alan and getting his insight to further our training methods and the artistic development of our dancers.
