An annual per student registration fee is due upon enrollment. Seventy Five Dollars (\$75.00) for the Professional Program and fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the Pre-Ballet/Primary Program. This fee is non-refundable and covers insurance, administrative fees and the Student Demonstration participation fee.

Tuition is due on the 1st day of the month due and if received after 5:00 pm on the 7th, a late fee will be applied to my account in accordance with the tuition payment structure to which I have agreed. Late fees will be applied each month that a balance is past due. Checks payable to The Studio and cash are acceptable payment. Credit/Debit cards are not accepted by the Studio. A fee of \$25.00 will be charged per returned check.

I understand that I will not receive an invoice or statement as a payment reminder.

Sibling Discount: 10% off full tuition for the second and subsequent participating students.

We understand that the Professional Program requires a commitment from both student and parent(s). Enrollment is for the entire season, from September through the June Student Demonstration. Neither refunds nor credit will be given for periods of non-attendance due to enrollment in another program. Prolonged absence may necessitate reassessment of level placement. The progression of the academy syllabus is based upon a student studying consistently for the year, including through the summer.

I understand that a thirty-day advance notice is required to drop from the program at any time, for reasons other than prolonged illness or injury. Tuition is due during that 30 day period. Credit toward future sessions is given with a doctor's written diagnosis.

We agree to notify the office in case of illness, injury or if the dancer must miss class for any reason. Tardy students will be admitted into class to observe.

Missed classes may be made up within 28 days in a lower level.

It is highly recommended that students take extra classes below their given level, these classes are provided free of charge to all of the Professional Training Program students. Mastery of the basics is the foundation for sound technique and advancement.

Families with past due balances are not assured a space in subsequent programs until accounts are brought up to date.

Any requests for changes to this agreement must be addressed in writing to Diane Cypher and Robert Kelley. This includes but is not limited to 'trade of services.'
