The Samper Recital Hall is right across from the Crocker Theater on the Cabrillo College campus.

Dancers are not allowed to leave the theater once they have signed in, until the completion of the showing. Pre-Ballet and Primary dancers will be escorted into the audience to watch the rest of the showing with their class. 
